

## Environmental and Sustainability Policy

AB Fruits recognises that businesses can have a negative impact on the environment. We are committed to providing a quality service in a manner that minimises our potential impact on the environment. We aim to comply with all relevant environmental legislation, regulations and requirements and to reduce the impact of our work across both our storage and distribution activities.

We commit to:

- Take environmental considerations and concerns into our decision making activities
- Reduce the amount of waste material produced and recycle waste material where possible
- Reduce the use of paper and unnecessary travel, through the use of telephone or email for communication.
- Reuse waste paper (i.e. from the printer), making use of the blank side for notes etc
- Making use of recycling schemes by the printer manufacturers (to recycle toner cartridges and drums)
- Purchase products made with recycled paper. For example, laser paper, toilet paper
- Keep energy usage low. For example, making use of low energy light bulbs throughout and ensuring electrical equipment is turned off when not in use
- Avoid unnecessary use of hazardous materials and products, replacing with environmentally friendly products where possible, and taking all reasonable steps to protect human health and the environment when such materials must be used, stored and disposed of
- Minimise environmental impacts with regard to air quality via the use of lower emission vehicles, regular maintenance and servicing of the vehicles, sensible planning of delivery routes and avoiding second runs by getting customer orders right first time.

We will periodically review our environmental policy with the aim of continually improving our environmental performance.
